MASTERCLASS

An opportunity for employers to deliver a masterclass that links subjects and topics within the curriculum to provide students with industry insights.

Employers are provided with the subject of the lesson, and invited to the classroom, either on site, or virtually, to provide students with industry insights.

COLLABORATIVE PROJECT-BASED LEARNING

An opportunity for employers to design and work with students to deliver a project within vocational subjects in the curriculum.

Employers receive full support in designing an engaging project that aligns with a specific unit in the curriculum.

Employers are then invited to the classroom, either on site, or virtually.



INDUSTRY INSIGHTS

As an employer you will host a teacher or small group of teachers on site at your business premises for a period of 3 or more days. Teachers are provided with insights into how your business operates and how this is relevant to the curriculum they are teaching.

Teachers will then create new lesson plans using their new industry-leading knowledge. Together we will create industry relevant education to secure your future pipeline.

STUDENT PLACEMENT

Your business works with a student or a group of students over an extended period to develop and accelerate specific skills. This placement forms part of their T Level Qualification
